Peter is a pillar of strength in the maritime industry and he is highly respected by many who have worked alongside him during his six-year term in the maritime industry.

Our joint initiative, MaritimeONE, was also selected as one of the 13 winning projects for the Minister's Innovation Award, conferred by the Ministry of Transport in 2008.
6. These would not have been possible without the able leadership of Peter and his team of committed Board of Directors and dedicated maritime professionals in MPA. These developments have reinforced the reputation of Singapore as an International Maritime Centre and made the Singapore maritime scene more vibrant.
