**Singapore, 28 November 2024** — The Singapore Maritime Foundation (SMF) and Mitsui O.S.K. Lines, Ltd. (MOL) yesterday signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to enhance cooperation in developing a talent pipeline for the maritime industry through the MaritimeONE Scholarship Programme.
